
We talked about different jobs and the commitment it takes to be successful. We spent time researching a range of jobs and learned more about the skills and qualities need

We read about the two disciples who spent the day with Jesus and talked about this made them feel.






Imagine you are John the Baptist recalling this event in your diary.

We studied the process involved in becoming a priest and wrote letters of advice to men who believe they are being called into the priesthood.






