Entries must be submitted by 11th November from your school to email: Customerengagement@westlancs.gov.uk.

One winner and two runners up will be selected in November 2022 and schools will be informed of the winning entries by email and asked to provide the hard copy of the winning design by post.

Terms and conditions

- 1.By entering the competition, entrants are deemed to have accepted, and agreed to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
- 2.Entry to the competition is open to all pupils attending primary schools in West Lancashire.
- 3.The closing date for entries is midnight on 11th November 2021.
- 4.Entrants must draw or paint a picture/poem/carol at school or at home using "Be kind to each other" as their theme.
- 5.Entries must be:
 - Created on white A4 paper, portrait only.
 - Must be in colour – coloured pencils, paint, crayons and felt tips can all be used. Please do not stick on any additional material e.g. tinsel, glitter or sequins on to the entry.
- 6.Schools may submit multiple entries but only one entry per pupil will be accepted
- 7.Entries must be emailed from the school to customerengagement@westlancs.gov.uk
- 8.All entries should be scanned and submitted by email in the following format:
 - Email subject: Christmas Card Competition
 - Name of the school
 - Please specify the year group each drawing belongs to e.g. early years, key stage 1 or 2. N.B. schools should be able to identify drawing to pupil, however, names of pupils should not be submitted with the initial entries.
- 9.There are no cash alternatives for winning entrants.
10. Winning entrant will have their artwork displayed as the official Christmas card for West Lancashire Borough Council.

- 11.One winning entrant will be chosen and two runners up.
- 12.Winner will be notified to the school by email.
- 13.The winner and runner ups will receive a prize.
- 14.West Lancashire Borough Council accepts no responsibility for late, lost, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, delayed, or misdirected entries.
- 15.West Lancashire Borough Council will appoint a fair and impartial judging panel to judge entries and select one winner and two runner ups.
- 16.Winner and runner ups will be selected from all valid entries.
- 17.We aim to invite the winner(s) to participate in publicity surround the competition which would include naming the winner(s) and a photo opportunity if possible.
- 18.By entering the competition, the parent/guardian will be invited to complete a media consent form if their child's entry is short listed.
- 19.The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into other than to notify the winning entrants.
