Prophecy and Promise Pupils will look at women in the Old Testament and see Mary's place in salvation history as she is presented in the gospel of St John	Galilee to Jerusalem Pupils will look at St John's account of Jesus through the seven miraculous signs and they will learn about the seven sacraments of the Catholic Church. Desert to Garden Pupils will hear the account of Jesus' Passion as recounted in St John's gospel and reflect on this as a source of creative inspiration.	To the Ends of the Earth The account of Mary meeting the resurrected Jesus in the garden will connect with the story of Eden and help pupils understand something of the narrative sequence of salvation history Dialogue and Encounter Pupils will consider Catholic social teaching as part of the call to dialogue with the culture of the time.
