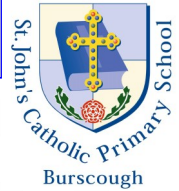


Note from the Head

Gospel Reading: John 13:31-35

The readings encourage us to love one another as Jesus loves us, to find strength and support in community, and to persevere through difficulties in our journey towards the Kingdom of God. They also remind us of the ultimate reward of eternal joy and the promise that God will wipe away all tears and eliminate suffering in the new order of heaven.

Approaching the Gospel with children

Jesus tells his disciples that he will not be with them much longer and he tells them how he'd like them to behave. Jesus told the disciples to love one another, just as he had loved them.
